



HENNIE JOUBERT PIANO COMPETITION

The 16th Hennie Joubert National Piano Competition will be held at the Stellenbosch Konservatorium's Endler Hall from 23 to 28 March 2026. Entries close on 27 January 2026



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About the competition:

The Hennie Joubert Piano Competition is held during the Stellenbosch International Piano Symposium: an enriching week during which pianists and teachers from around the country can immerse themselves in “everything piano”. Between 23 and 28 March 2026, young pianists can perform in front of a selected jury of professional pianists (including international pianists) while finalists will perform with the Cape Town Philharmonic Orchestra. Repertoire requirements aim to serve as an introduction to larger scale competitions for pianists, 19 years and younger. Embarking on the process of learning this demanding body of music forms the educational cornerstone of the competition, and because of this we believe that entering or participating in the competition serves to the benefit of any young musician. The Stellenbosch International Piano Symposium is presented simultaneously (an optional separate entry) and offers the further opportunity for young learners to attend master classes with local and international artists, presentations as well as recitals.

The Hennie Joubert Piano Competition already started in 1983 when the South African piano manufacturer Dietman proposed a sponsorship for the promotion of the performing arts to the Wellington Music Society, through their contact with Dr Manie Rust. It was decided to use the funds to start a new piano competition. Joan de Villiers (chair of the Wellington Music Society) contacted Hannelie Prinsloo, André Serfontein and Bennie van Eeden to serve with her as founding members of the Dietman Piano Competition. The first competition was held in 1984 with Virginia Fortesque, Bennie van Eeden and Cecilia Lourens as judges. In later years John Roos, Hubert van der Spuy, Juliana de Villiers, James May, Hendrik Hofmeyr, Johan de Klerk, Ian Smith, Ruth Goveia en Mari Gerdes served on the panel.

The year 1986 was marked by the untimely passing of one of South Africa’s most influential musicians. It was decided that the Dietman Piano Competition will be renamed in memory of Hennie Joubert to the Hennie Joubert Piano Competition. Subsequently the competition has grown into the most prestigious piano competition for South African youth. Previous contestants reads like a “who’s who” of the South African music industry.

The competition was first held in the Goodnow Hall of the then Wellington Teacher’s College. Initially the final round was performed with a second piano in the Wellington Town Hall. Later the final round was moved to the Endler Hall in Stellenbosch and performed with orchestra. After 20 years the competition temporarily came to a halt. In 2011 André Serfontein who acted as competition organizer over many years, contacted the Department of Music at Stellenbosch University, who decided to continue the competition as part of the biennial Piano Symposium. Through the generous sponsorship of the Rupert Music Foundation, Cape Town Philharmonic, Yamaha and Global Music, the 2012 Hennie Joubert Piano Competition was once more announced, with a founding member: Bennie van Eeden, serving on the panel of judges. Continued sponsorship and a relationship with key partners such as the Cape Town Philharmonic Orchestra has continued to make the competition a reality, so that the Hennie Joubert Pianoforte Competition can continue the development of the most talented young pianists in South Africa.

PARTICIPATION RULES

1. All South African citizens and residents up to 19 years on 28 March 2026 may enter.
2. Previous first prize winners may not enter.
3. An entry fee of R350 will be charged.
4. Closing date for entries: 27 January 2026.
5. To participate in Round 1 all entrants must present a recording for adjudication. (See Repertoire List: Round 1)
6. An electronic link (YouTube preferred) must be submitted by e-mail. Alternatively a CD-recording can be mailed to: 2024 Hennie Joubert Pianoforte Competition Conservatory of Music Private Bag X1 Matieland, 7602.
7. The recording must be received no later than 27 January 2026, certified as original by your teacher, parent or commissioner of oath.
8. The chosen repertoire must be indicated correctly and in full on the official online entry form.
9. A quality photo (sufficient definition for publication in the programme) must be uploaded with the online entry.

11. Candidates may include additional works to conform to the overall time limit of round 3.
12. The time limit for the Final Round must be carefully checked. If the chosen movement does not meet the required minimum time limit, another movement from the same work may be added.

13. All entries will be subjected to a process of elimination in the first round. Only 10 candidates will be invited to participate in the second round and will be informed no later than the end of 1 February 2024.

14. Five candidates can participate in the final round with the Cape Town Philharmonic Orchestra

First round

23 March 2026 in the Endler Hall, Stellenbosch

Third round

24 March 2026 in the Endler Hall, after which the finalists will be announced.

Final Round

28 March 2026 in the Endler Hall, with the Cape Town Philharmonic Orchestra.

- **Your recital in the third round must be between 30 and 35 minutes in length.**
- **All sections must be rendered from memory.**
- **Copies of works presented may be requested by the selection committee.**
- **Rehearsal facilities available.**

Round 1 – Recording

2. One virtuoso Etude as prescribed for round 2.
3. The first movement from a Sonata as prescribed for round 3.
4. Any work from the Romantic or late-Romantic period.

Round 2

1. One Prelude and Fugue from J.S. Bach's Das Wohltemperiertes Klavier
2. Any virtuoso Etude (examples by Chopin, Liszt, Rachmaninoff, Scriabin, Stravinsky, Prokofieff, Bartók and Kapustin – amongst various others).
3. Any South African work

Round 3

(A programme of 30 to 35 minutes in length.)

1. One complete Classical sonata
2. Any work from the Romantic or late Romantic period. The Romantic work presented for the recording round may be repeated.
3. Any work from the 20th- or 21st -Century (Not South African)

* Candidates may include additional works to conform to the overall time limit.

Meer oor die kompetisie:

Die Hennie Joubert Klavierkompetisie vind tydens die Stellenbosch Internasionale Klaviersimposium plaas: 'n verrykende week waarin pianiste van dwars oor die land hulle in alles wat met die klavier te make het kan verdiep. Hierdie kompetisie bied aan pianiste 19 jaar en jonger die geleentheid om terugvoer vanaf 'n 'n uitgesoekte paneel (wat internasionale pianiste insluit) te kry, en vir die finaliste om saam met die Kaapse Filharmoniese Orkes op te tree. Die repertorium vereistes stel ten doel om as inleiding tot kompetisies van 'n groter skaal te lei. Vir ons vorm hierdie leerproses die hoeksteen van die kompetisie en juis hieroor glo ons dat dit tot voordeel van elke pianis se ontwikkeling is om in te skryf en deel te neem: elke pianis se reis is anders en selfs om hierdie magtige repertorium te begin aanpak is 'n belangrike mylpaal vir 'n jong pianis. Die Stellenbosch Internasionale Klaviersimposium wat gelyktydig plaasvind ('n aparte vrywillige inskrywing) bied die verdere geleentheid vir meestersklasse by plaaslike en internasionale pianiste, lesings en om recitals by te woon.

Die kompetisie is reeds in 1983 beplan toe die Suid-Afrikaanse klaviervervaardiger Dietman die Wellingtonse Musiekvereniging deur Dr Manie Rust gekontak het met 'n borgskap vir die bevordering van die uitvoerende kunste. Daar is besluit om die fondse te gebruik vir 'n nuwe klavierkompetisie. Kort daarna het Joan de Villiers (voorsitter van die Wellingtonse Musiekvereniging) vir Hannelie Prinsloo, André Serfontein en Bennie van Eeden genader om saam met haar as stigterslede vir die Dietman Klavierkompetisie te dien. Die eerste kompetisie het in 1984 plaasgevind met Virginia Fortesque, Bennie van Eeden en Cecilia Lourens as beoordelaars. Latere beoordelaars sluit in John Roos, Hubert van der Spuy, Juliana de Villiers, James May, Hendrik Hofmeyr, Johan de Klerk, Ian Smith, Ruth Goveia en Mari Gerdes.

In 1986 sterf een van die mees invloedryke musici wat Suid Afrika nog opgelewer het onverwags, en word daar besluit om die Dietman Klavierkompetisie ter nagedagtenis aan Hennie Joubert te herdoop na die Hennie Joubert-Klavierkompetisie. Die Hennie Joubert-Klavierkompetisie word sedertdien erken as die mees prestigeryke klavierkompetisie vir die Suid-Afrikaanse jeug. Vorige deelnemers aan die kompetisie lees soos 'n lys van die mees toonaangewende musici van Suid-Afrika.

Die Hennie Joubert Klavierkompetisie is in die Goodnowsaal van die destydse Onderwyserskollege op Wellington gehou. Aanvanklik was die finale ronde saam met 'n tweede klavier uitgevoer in die Wellingtonse Stadsaal, maar later is die finaal saam met orkes in die Endlersaal op Stellenbosch gehou. Na 20 jaar het die kompetisie tydelik tot stilstand gekom. André Serfontein wat deur die jare as organiseerder vir die Hennie Joubert-Klavierkompetisie opgetree het, nader in 2011 die Departement Musiek aan Stellenbosch Universiteit wat besluit om die kompetisie as deel van die tweejaarlikse Klaviersimposium voort te sit. Deur mildelike borgskappe van die Rupert Musiekstigting, Die Kaapstad Filharmoniese Orkes, Yamaha en Global Music word die 2012 Hennie Joubert-Klavierkompetisie weer in die lewe geroep met een van die stigterslede: Bennie van Eeden, wat op die beoordelingspaneel dien. Sedertdien maak hierdie borge en sleutelvennote soos die Kaapstad Filharmoniese Orkes dit weereens moontlik vir die Hennie Joubert Klavierkompetisie om die ontwikkeling van die mees talentvolle jong pianiste in Suid-Afrika voort te sit.
